## **Membership Renewal Update**

All renewals received by Monday January 20th have been processed and the 2020 photo membership cards have been mailed out where applicable.

The exceptions are:

If you paid an incorrect amount you will have received an email explaining the error and asked how/if you want to proceed with your renewal. The outstanding amount must be received by January 31 or your renewal will be rejected. If you did not send a signed renewal form, your 2020 membership card will not be issued until a signed renewal form is received. It can be mailed, left in the drop box or a scan/photo of it emailed.

If you did not send a photo of yourself, your 2020 membership card will not be issued until one is received. It does not have to be a passport photo, one taken with a cell phone is fine.

If your membership is a family membership, we also need a photo for your spouse and any children over 17 that have a PAL. This is to ensure that we can identify anybody that can legally attend the range on their own with a firearm through to our membership year end on December 31, 2020. No membership cards will be issued until we have all required family photos.

We will issue spousal cards without a photo if the spouse does not have a PAL. Children are normally issued green youth card without a photo. In these cases, the spouse/children must be under the supervision of a member with a valid PAL.

Any renewals received after January 31st will be rejected and your place made available to somebody on our waiting list. You will have to rejoin the club going through the standard joining process. This includes applying through the waiting list when open, taking the current safety course and paying the fees applicable to new members.

If you have not received you renewal package in the mail yet and you submitted all required information (payment, signed renewal form, photo) more than 2 weeks ago please contact <a href="mailto:renewals@ltvfg.ca">renewals@ltvfg.ca</a> so we can check to see what the issue might be.

# Without this card you can not be at the club starting January 1, 2020.

A good idea is to take a picture of your new ID card with your smart phone if you have one, so you always have your membership card with you.

Membership into the club is now closed until at least all renewals have been completed and the January 31, 2020 deadline has passed.

#### **New Member Intake**

Using the new online intake system worked great. We have 200 names on the current waiting list. The first group of potential new members is on Saturday January 25. This is by INVITE ONLY. I hope to start doing new member information sessions every other weekend time permitting and instructor time permitting.

Once the renewals have been completed and we know how many current members did not renew or pay their membership on time we will know how many more new members we can bring into the club after the first group intake has completed.
