Range Use

If the target backers will no longer support a target, remove the target backers, and take them to the front of the range by the Range Use sign. DO NOT put them in the shed. Then go to the club house and get replacement backers. Only take what you need.

Clean up all your shell cases and remove all targets. Make sure the range is clean for the next member. Report any problems by email to president@ltvfg.ca and note the range, time, and date.

Range limitations and restrictions are as follows,

Range #1 9 bench positions.

Ranges #2 to #5 are still limited to 5 people per range for physical distancing.

Range #6 (TRAP) is closed for the winter

Range #7 (SKEET) is open for personal use with a 5-person limit

Range #8 (Sporting Clay) is Open Sundays as normal with physical distancing required.

Ranges #9 and #10 (Indoor) are still limited to 2 people per range for physical distancing.
