Projects and maintenance, there are a few projects that are gearing up around the club.

- Sporting Clay culvert river stone installation. This will finish off the culvert that replaced the old wooden bridge.
- Driveway/parking repairs. The spring melt took its toll in a few spots creating some potholes on the main driveway and some in the parking area. For the driveway, we are going to have a catch basin and culvert installed where the runoff pooled. This work will require a 1-day club closure. We will post on our web site once we have a firm date.
- Archery parking area asphalt, we are going to have the parking area paved.
- Range #1 Backstop repairs from the spring melt.
- Range #2 Drainage ditch will be installed at the base of the 200 m to run across the range to the north ditch to help stop the range base from flooding.
- Pathway for Property Boundary is progressing. We have taken the summer off as this work is all in the bush around the property.
- Sporting clay's main storage building roof has developed a leaky roof. We will be getting quotes to repair or replace the entire roof on this building.
- Club house upstairs washroom, we will be getting quotes to upgrade this existing washroom from female only into two separate accessible multi use washrooms to better serve our members.
- Network cabling installation still has two sections of fiber cabling to be installed over the next few weeks.
- Range #5 maintenance, over the summer we will be closing Range #5 to do some much-needed maintenance on the side berm and backstop. The range will be closed for the work.
- CFO inspection, it is our year for the CFO to inspect all our ranges. This will require a full day facility closure. Watch our web site for details.
- Archery 3D Targets, winter has taken its toll on 4 of the targets and it seems 1 target has been removed from club property. These targets are very costly so please NO BROADHEAD points. Their replacement targets are on order.
- Port-A-Potties, there are two more units on order and should be at the club any day now. If you notice the supplies are getting low or the units are getting full, please let us know.

Please DO NOT put large pieces of cardboard or spent casing/shells in the garbage cans. All cardboard should be put in the sheds on each range. Spent casings and shells should be put in the range pails on each range. Used up target board should be placed beside the range sheds, not inside or left on the range.
