# **Donations to OIC gun ban challenges**

Over the last 12 months the club has made \$500 donations to various groups that have court challenges to the government OIC gun ban. We have tried to spread our donations around especially to those groups that have struggled to meet their donation targets. Most of the cases are using the Constitution or the Bill of Rights to challenge the government. Most have been bogged down during the summer in motions by both parties and court cases are not likely to be heard until Spring 2022.

The challenge by Alberta Tactical Rifle is different in that it is challenging the legality of the Firearms Reference Table and the overreach by RCMP employees in their interpretations of the OIC in making changes to the FRT. The judge has ruled on the various motions and attempts to get the case thrown out and is allowing it to go ahead. To help with funding for this challenge the club has just donated \$2500.

We will continue to monitor the status of the various court cases and help with funding where appropriate.

#### **Port-A-Potties:**

I have been advised by Bill's John's that some members have been depositing feminine hygiene products and adult and child diapers in the port-a-potties holding tanks. These items are NOT to be dropped into the holding tanks as they will plug up the vacuum equipment used to empty the holding tanks and could lead to damage. We have installed sanitary waste units in each unit.

### Range Update:

#### Range #1

The eavestroughs have been installed on the structure. This is part one of the drainage project for this range. We still must trench across the road and install piping to direct the water to where we would like it to go.

We have been given the CFO approval to expand Range #4 by moving the right-side berm closer to the backstop/side berm on Range #3. This will widen this range by about 30 feet. We will be developing a plan and getting a budget for this work.

## Range #12 NEW

We have in principle, been given the approval to build a new Range #12 between Ranges #5 and Ranges #6/7. This will be a long-term project. This new range will be 200m when finished. There is much planning before we start. We hope to start in 2022 but it will take a few years before the range will be open for use.

We are also seeking to get in 2022 approval for a multi-lane range for target shooting only. More details to follow in 2022.
