Sunny days and nice weather are just around the corner. Bringing guests to the club is a great way to introduce new shooters to our sports. But there are things you must remember. We have limited guest badges (40) for a reason. When all the guest badges have been signed out, you and your guests must wait for someone to return enough guest badges for your guests. Guests are not permitted on the ranges without a badge. Guests must be always with you. Guest must tap in and out at each ranges used just like members and their families. The limit of guests is set per membership. Single or family are only permitted 4 guests as any one time. Remember that everyone you bring, including children of any age are guests if they are not on your membership.

Parking is limited until further notice. As the weather gets nicer the grounds will dry out and allow us to open more parking areas. But until then, these areas will remain closed to vehicle traffic so that the grass does not get damaged.
