### **Steel & Bunkers**

Have you ever wondered why it takes time before the steel plates are replaced in the bunkers?

For the winter shooting, only one plate will be placed in each bunker. This will be from November to the following April.

When you are shooting at the plates and a bolt breaks, you are required to stop shooting and remove a plate in this condition. Put it in the club house on the work bench.
