Reminders

Guests must be signed in before you go to a bay.

Members and guests must tap in and out at each bay you use.

You must always supervise your guests licensed or not licensed.

You must pick up all casings.

You must take down your target used or not.

Used backers should be brought to the front of the bay.

Broke steel targets must be removed from the bunker and brought to the front of the bay.

Do the outhouses need servicing, please message the club.

See something broken or needing updating, report it to the club.

Workdays, 2 - 4 hour workdays such as Sunday morning or 1 full day workday such as Ladies or Youth day or any event at the club.

If you are over 70 or have a disability permit and you have not previously informed us and do not show as exempt, please send a copy of your drivers licence or disability parking permit to renewals@ltvfg.ca and we will set you to exempt.

Shotgun bays, the maximum size of bore is 12 gauge or smaller, no 10 gauge. The maximum size of shot is birdshot 7 1/2 or 8, no 5 or 6. No buckshot such as 00, 04, etc. Targets must be clay birds, if you want to sight in for hunting use a rifle range and normal target.

No birdshot or buckshot allowed in the bunkers.
